Technical Order

PARACHUTE LOGS AND RECORDS

T.O. 00-25-241, 1 February 1997, is supplemented as follows:

2b. The Wing/Group Commander determines if unit identification is entered or omitted on AFTO/DD forms or stenciled on equipment.

3a(1)(d). The Wing/Group Commander determines if unit identification is entered or omitted on AFTO/DD forms.

3a(1)(g). (Note): The Wing/Group Commander determines if unit identification is entered or omitted on AFTO/DD forms.

3a(4)(d). (Note): The Wing/Group Commander determines if unit identification is entered or omitted on AFTO/DD forms.

4. (Note): The AFTO Form 392 is maintained in addition to CAMS documentation. A PC based software program may be used to produce a near facsimile of AFTO Form 392, as long as all information in paragraph 4 of the basic T.O. is included.

4b. The Wing/Group Commander establishes a master file system of AFTO Forms 392 so that the current status of each "In Service" parachute or torso harness can be readily determined.

4c. (Note): The Wing/Group Commander determines if the back side of the form is utilized.
