MEMORANDUM FOR The Adjutants General of all States, Puerto Rico, the US Virgin Islands, Guam, and the Commanding General of the District of Columbia

SUBJECT: Interim Policy Governing Extension, Immediate Reenlistment, and Bar to Reenlistment/Immediate Reenlistment/Extension (NGB-ARH Policy Memorandum # 09-026)

1. References.

- a. NGR 600-200, Enlisted Personnel Management, 31 July 2009.
- b. AR 601-280, Army Retention Program, 31 January 2006.

2. The recently released NGR 600-200 dated 31 July 2009, does not contain policy guidance for extensions and immediate reenlistments. The intent was to integrate ARNG reenlistment policy into an all component AR 601-280. Unfortunately, AR 601-280 has not been fielded on schedule, thereby creating a void in official guidance.

3. The enclosed interim policy (see the attached Annex A), Extension, Immediate Reenlistment, and Bar to Reenlistment/Immediate Reenlistment/Extension; is approved for use until publication of a new AR 601-280. This policy supersedes the previous 1989 version of NGR 600-200, Chapter 7, addressing extensions and reenlistments.

4. The newly released NGR 600-200, Chapter 7, Army National Guard Command Sergeant Major Program, addresses a completely different topic than its predecessor and is in effect as of 31 July 2009.
