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Air Force Manual (AFMAN) 23-110, Volume 2, Part 2, Chapter 22, United States Air Force Supply Manual is supplemented as follows. This publication applies to all Air National Guard (ANG) units. 22.22.6. **NOTE:** ANG delegates this option to the discretion of the LRS Commander.

22.23.2. The ANG Support Equipment Transformation (SET) CoP in the AF Portal has the master contact spreadsheets for EAEs and ANG CEMO supply managers.

22.29.2.1.1. **(Added)** Commanders may only appoint full-time members, i.e. AGR or Technician, as primary equipment custodians. Alternate custodians may be traditional guardsmen.

22.94.2.1.3. ANG will not deploy installed support equipment on aircraft because it is installed and will return with the aircraft.

**TAB E (ADDED)** 3. Create a local template to provide to unit custodians for their monthly SA/LW inventories and provide to them with their CA/CRL, so they may sign and return the signed letter when their inventory is complete. This copy should be maintained with the latest inventory IAW AFMAN 23-110, Vol II, Part Two, Ch 10, Para 10C23.4.7. At a minimum, the letter should state that the “Monthly SA/LW Inventory has been accomplished IAW AFMAN 23-110, Vol II, Part Two, Ch 10”, date inventory was accomplished, signature and printed name of custodian, organizational account, number of weapons inventoried, number of discrepancies, detailed description of discrepancies and action taken to correct them.
