The purpose of this Technical Order (TO) is to explain how to prepare, replace and dispose of AFTO Form 391, *Parachute Log*, and AFTO Form 392, *Parachute Repack, Inspection, and Component Record*, that are used to log and record parachute information. TO 00-25-241, 01 February 1997 is supplemented as follows.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS

This document is substantially revised and must be completely reviewed.

2b. The Wing/Group Commander determines if unit identification is entered or omitted on AFTO/DD forms or stenciled on equipment.

3a(1)(d). The Wing/Group Commander determines if unit identification is entered or omitted on AFTO/DD forms.

3a(1)(g). (**NOTE**): The Wing/Group Commander determines if unit identification is entered or omitted on AFTO/DD forms.

3a(4)(d). (**NOTE**): The Wing/Group Commander determines if unit identification is entered or omitted on AFTO/DD forms.

4. (**NOTE**): The AFTO Form 392 is maintained in addition to CAMS documentation. A PC based software program may be used to produce a near facsimile of AFTO Form 392, as long as all information in Paragraph 4., of the basic TO is included.

4b. The Wing/Group Commander establishes a master file system of AFTO Forms 392 so that the current status of each "In Service" parachute or torso harness can be readily determined.

4c. (Note): The Wing/Group Commander determines if the backside of the form is utilized.
