EXTENDING TITLE 32 ORDERS FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF TAKING LEAVE

Reference(s): See Enclosure.

1. Purpose. To disseminate guidance on the extension of Title 32 U.S.C. orders for the sole purpose of ensuring that soldiers serving on Title 32 orders have the opportunity to use accrued leave as required.
2. Cancellation. All States Memorandum, 15 March 2010, subject: Extending Title 32 Orders for the Sole Purpose of Taking Leave is hereby cancelled.
3. Applicability. This notice is applicable to all States, Territories, and the District of Columbia, and all elements of the National Guard Bureau where Soldiers are serving on orders under Title 32 U.S.C.
4. Background. DoDI 1327.6, Reference a, paragraph 1.b (7), states that a Reserve Component member who accumulates leave during a period of active service may carry over any leave so accumulated to the member's next period of active service, subject to the accumulation limits in section 701 of Reference e, without regard to separation or release from active service if the separation or release is under honorable conditions. The addition of this language reduces the need to use leave as a method of compensation or as a career continuation incentive through the accrual of large leave balances, which contradicts the intent of Congress to provide for the health and welfare of Service members. Other regulations and fiscal law constraints impact tour extensions as well.
5. Action or Procedure. Reference a, requires and outlines that Commanders at all levels ensure that Service members are provided the opportunity, consistent with operational requirements, to take leave. Service members should continue to be provided the opportunity to take leave before the end of their tour. Title 32 orders will not be extended for the sole purpose of taking leave.
