1. Purpose. This notice establishes interim guidance for National Guard (NG) Weapons of Mass Destruction-Civil Support Teams (WMD-CST) in accordance with the references.
2. Cancellation. None.
3. Applicability. This notice applies to all NG WMD-CSTs.
4. Background. In July of 2014, reference a was published which superseded the authorities, responsibilities, and policy portions of NG Regulation 500-3/Air National Guard Instruction 10-2503, 09 May 2011, "Weapons of Mass Destruction Civil Support Team Management." The procedural guidance remained valid through 31 December 2016, at which point the entire regulation became obsolete. The coinciding Chief of the National Guard Bureau (CNGB) Manual is currently being staffed for coordination; however, this leaves a gap in procedural guidance for all NG WMD-CSTs.

5. Action or Procedure. The Domestic Operations and Force Development Directorate Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear Response Enterprise WMD-CST Branch (NGB-J39) will publish the draft CNGB Manual by 31 December 2017. In the interim, all WMD-CSTs will utilize the NGB-J39 procedural guidance in the document located in the Doctrine and References folder at reference c.
