
INTERIM REVISION TO CNGBI 5000.01, 30 NOVEMBER 2011, "CHIEF, NATIONAL GUARD BUREAU ISSUANCES AND NATIONAL GUARD BUREAU PUBLICATIONS GUIDANCE"

Reference: CNGB Instruction 5000.01, 30 November 2011, "Chief, National Guard Bureau Issuances and National Guard Bureau Publications Guidance"

1. Purpose. This notice extends the deadline for conversion or rescission of National Guard Bureau (NGB) documents from 31 October 2014 to 31 October 2015 in accordance with the reference.
2. Cancellation. None.
3. Applicability. This notice applies to all elements of the NGB.
4. Background. The reference established the Chief of the National Guard (CNGB) issuance program. Paragraph 4.b. of the reference requires all existing CNGB and NGB Joint Publications and Joint Policies to be converted into a CNGB Instruction, CNGB Manual, or CNGB Notice on their next reissuance or no later than (NLT) 31 October 2013.
5. Action or Procedure. Change the second and third sentences of Paragraph 4.b. to read: "All current CNGB and NGB Joint Publications and Joint Policies that are not one of the three CNGB Issuances will be converted NLT 31 October 2015. Documents not converted on 31 October 2015 will be rescinded."
6. Releasability. This notice is approved for public release; distribution is unlimited. Copies are available through <<http://www.ngbpdc.ngb.army.mil>>.

7. Effective Date. This notice is effective on the date signed and will expire one year from the date of signature unless cancelled earlier.
